Aug 25: first day to apply for absentee ballot

Sept 29: clerk's begin mailing ballots; in-person voting starts at your clerk's office

Oct 24: last day to register to vote on-line

Oct 25-Nov 8: register to vote at your clerk's office with proof of residency

Nov 7: last day to vote in-person at your clerk's office

Nov 8: Vote at your precinct 7 am – 8 pm

Proposal 22-2 A YES vote for **Promote the Vote** guarantees an individual Constitutional right to vote and protects the integrity and security of our elections. It establishes 9 days of early voting, requires accessible drop boxes and streamlines absentee voting, with more time for military and overseas voters to get their ballots in.

Proposal 22-3 A YES vote for **Reproductive Freedom for All** ensures a Constitutional right to make and carryout decisions without political interference about all matters relating to pregnancy, including birth control, abortion, prenatal care and childbirth.
